



REHAB LA SHARE GRANT PROGRAM

Louisiana citizens who are over 55 years of age and/or disabled, and own their home can receive money to restore their disaster-damaged homes through the REHAB LA SHARE Grant Program. The program helps older and disabled citizens who live in federally declared disaster areas, like the areas hit by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. Applicants can receive up to \$25,000 in grants to bring their homes up to International Building Code Standards.

Just the Facts:

- Open to families with at least one homeowner who is over the age of 55 or disabled and who meet local income guidelines
- Program provides grants up to \$25,000 to rehabilitate homes
- Homes must be substandard and located in Acadia, Evangeline, Orleans, Sabine, St. Landry and Washington parishes (check website or call for updates)
- Applications are through local parish offices
